May Slagle's name appears in our archives frequently. Many current members will remember May as a long time and indispensable office manager of May Memorial. As noted in *May No One Be A Stranger* (p. 45) "in the minds of many church school children who heard their parents mention May Slagle, she, not the minister from 100 years ago, was the source of the church name." May was one of the most active of all our volunteers in the school lunch program the church sponsored and ran during WWII. She edited the church newsletter, for many years, too.
